

Modern Slavery Statement

Cliffe Packaging Ltd is committed to driving out acts of modern slavery from within its own business and that from its supply chains. The company acknowledges responsibility to the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and will ensure transparency within the organisation and with suppliers of goods and services to the organisation.

The organisational structure of the business is a privately owned enterprise that supplies packaging to its customers, sourced from approved global manufacturing sites.

As part of the company's due diligence in supplier approval processes imported products from outside the UK and EU are potentially more at risk in relation to issues with slavery and human trafficking. The level of control required for these sources will be continually monitored for effectiveness.

Cliffe packaging Ltd will not support or deal with any business knowingly involved in slavery or human trafficking.

Cliffe Packaging Ltd Directors and Senior Management shall take the responsibility for implementing this policy statement and its objectives. They will provide adequate resources and investment to ensure that slavery and human trafficking does not take place within the organisation or within its supply chain.

This policy statement will be reviewed annually and displayed throughout our organisation.
